Background

- Metro Health is committed to develop the future workforce through this partnership with the CDC PHAP.
- CDC has placed 950 PHAPs across U.S. to date since 2007.
- PHAP Mission is to "train and provide experiential learning to early career professionals who contribute to the public health workforce."
- Geared to recent baccalaureate and master's level graduates.







Background

- Metro Health has been a host site for 9 years; hosting 17 associates total.
- We benefit from hosting these bright, energetic individuals from other areas of the U.S.
- Currently 4 PHAPs work throughout department and assist programs with delivery of services to community.







Fiscal Impact

- The CDC's PHAP program provides a salary paid directly to the assignee while they complete their two-year field assignments at the health agency.
- If selected assignment is from October 2018 to September 2020.
- There is no impact on the General Fund.
