

# **SEP-HCP AREA**




- Includes preservation in 7 counties:

# **INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**

- Between City, County and Texas Parks and Wildlife Department
  - 15 years
  - Protect areas within Government Canyon State Natural Area
    - Manage, fund and monitor protections of 6 Karst Fauna Areas (KFAs)
  - This action creates a baseline to support plan
  - No credits will be sold
