## **Brief Description of Item(s) and Use:**

This City-wide contract will provide various City of San Antonio departments with uniforms, safety footwear and accessories for staff in supporting roles such as custodial and maintenance, kitchen/chef, business/administration staff, and other trades. The uniform garments include pants, shorts, denim jeans, polo shirts, woven work shirts, woven commercial shirts, dress shirts and blouses, lightweight, mid-weight, and insulated heavy weight outerwear, vests, coveralls, and safety footwear.

This procurement is made utilizing the US Communities cooperative contract number 12-JLH-011C and will be made in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement number 97097 passed on 1/30/2003. This agreement will provide a non-exclusive contract for a wide variety of manufacturers of uniforms, safety footwear, and accessories.
