## AN ORDINANCE

RATIFYING A CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN FIRE PROTECTION GROUP, INC. FOR INSTALLATION OF A NEW UNDERGROUND PIPELINE AT THE TOWER OF THE AMERICAS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$195,684.00, FUNDED FROM THE FY 2017 CENTER CITY DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONS UTILITIES SAVINGS FUND.

WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by American Fire Protection Group, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Center City Development and Operations Department with a new underground pipeline in order to supply water to the fire protection sprinkler system for the Tower of the Americas for a total cost of \$195,684.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the new underground pipeline became necessary because of a sudden break in the existing pipeline, resulting in a total loss of fire protection for the Tower; and

WHEREAS, due to the exigent circumstances, installation of a new underground pipeline has been completed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(3), which provides for a procurement necessary because of unforeseen damage to public machinery, equipment, or other property; **NOW THEREFORE**:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1**. The contract with American Fire Protection Group, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Center City Development and Operations Department with a new underground pipeline in order to supply water to the fire protection sprinkler system at the Tower of the Americas for a total cost of \$195,684.00 is hereby ratified. A copy of the contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**.
