AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CHAPTER 380 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, THE TAX INCREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE NUMBER ELEVEN, AND GEORGE GERVIN YOUTH CENTER, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$450,000.00 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ECHO EAST PROJECT.

WHEREAS, tax increment financing is an economic development tool authorized the Tax Increment Financing Act (the "Act"), Chapter 311 of the Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act, the City through City Council Ordinance 93101, established Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number Eleven, known as the Inner City TIRZ ("TIRZ"), and a Board of Directors ("Board") authorized with all the rights, powers, and duties provided by the Act to such boards in order to promote development and revitalization activities within TIRZ; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Board recognize the importance of their continued role in economic development, community development, planning and urban design; and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2016, George Gervin Youth Center, Inc. ("GGYC") applied for TIRZ funding to purchase approximately 10 acres of vacant, abandoned property located at 301 Spriggsdale that sits adjacent to 10 acres owned by GGYC; and

WHEREAS, GGYC intends to utilize both parcels to facilitate the Echo East Mixed Use Development Project, which consists of the development of approximately 500 residential units, approximately 25,000 square feet of retail space, two parking structures, green space and recreational areas for open-air events, including the necessary public improvements; and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2017, the Board authorized staff to negotiate an agreement with GGYC for the reimbursement of land acquisition and appraisal costs associated with the purchase of the real property located at 301 Spriggsdale, San Antonio, Texas; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2017, the City of San Antonio Planning Commission declared the property, located at 301 Spriggsdale as surplus and approved the recommendation to permit the direct sale and conveyance of said property; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2017, the Board passed Resolution <u>T11 2017-05-12-01R</u>, which authorized the execution of a Chapter 380 Economic Development Grant Agreement with
