Right-of-Way Encroachment Permit

- HEB Grocery requesting a ROW encroachment permit to construct pedestrian bridge over Cesar Chavez
- Pedestrian bridge will connect HEB Headquarters to new HEB parking garage at 415 Dwyer Avenue
- Allows HEB partners to safely cross Cesar Chavez mid-block, between Main Avenue and Dwyer Avenue





Overhead Pedestrian Bridge

- 26 feet high and 18 feet wide
- Footings on HEB's property
- 50-year initial permit term with two 25 year renewals
- December 2017 HDRC approved design concept
- Construction to begin October 2018, completion by April 2019
