Proposed Westfort Historic District

The San Antonio Conservation Society supports historic designation of the proposed Westfort Historic District. Westfort's housing stock reflects the early-20th century trend towards promoting varied architectural styles within a single neighborhood. The proposed district includes an eclectic mix of styles, including Tudor, Craftsman, Prairie, Spanish Eclectic, Folk Victorian, post-war mid-century apartments, and Neoclassical homes.

Prominent residents of the Westfort neighborhood in the 1910s included Sunken Gardens architect, C. T. Boelhauwe; Frank Scobey, director of the US Mint; and Gutzon Borglum, artist and sculptor of the Mount Rushmore National Monument.

We support historic designation to preserve this unique community.
