

AN ORDINANCE 2018-04-12-0273

AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THREE (3) PARK POLICE OFFICER POSITIONS TO BE UTILIZED FOR THE SAN PEDRO CREEK PROJECT AND APPROPRIATES A CUMULATIVE AMOUNT OF \$4,185,916 FOR FY 2018 THROUGH FY 2034 TO THE FY 2018 PARK POLICE BUDGET TO BE FUNDED ANNUALLY THROUGH THE HOUSTON STREET TAX INCREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE #9.

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WHEREAS, the San Pedro Creek Improvement Project ("Project") will revitalize a two (2) mile segment of the creek through downtown San Antonio beginning at the IH-35 flood tunnel inlet near Fox Tech High School and ending at the confluence with Alazan and Apache Creeks at IH-35 near the stockyards; and

WHEREAS, the Project will be complete in four phases with Phase 1 anticipated to be completed in December 2018, and Phase 2 in May 2019; and

WHEREAS, City will provide safety and security along Phases 1 and 2 of the San Pedro Creek by adding three full time San Antonio Park Police Officer positions, equipment, and supplies necessary to provide an active patrol of the project through 2034,

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2018, the Houston Street Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone (TIRZ) #9 Board approved a resolution that provided funds to support three full time San Antonio Park Police Officers in the cumulative amount of \$4,185,916 from FY 2018 to FY 2034.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes three full time park police positions to provide active patrol on San Pedro Creek and appropriates approximately \$208,493 to the FY 2018 Park Police Budget which will be funded through the Houston Street TIRZ #9 as part of its cumulative commitment of funds authorized under Resolution T09-2018-02-26-01R; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. Three (3) full-time park police positions to provide active patrol on San Pedro Creek during Phases 1 and 2 of the San Pedro Creek Project are hereby approved funded through the Houston Street Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone #9.

SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the en days after passage.
