AN ORDINANCE 2018-04-19-0300

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL, AND ACCEPTANCE UPON AWARD, OF A 2018 PUBLIC ART CHALLENGE GRANT APPLICATION TO BLOOMBERG PHILANTHROPIES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000,000.00 FOR TWO YEARS BEGINNING LATE 2018, THE USE OF UP TO \$2,000,000.00 IN 2017 BOND FUNDS AS MATCH, AND THE EXECUTION OF ANY NECESSARY ANCILLARY AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, Bloomberg Philanthropies' Public Art Challenge is a component of the American Cities Initiative, which helps U.S. cities generate innovation and advance policy and the Public Art Challenge encourages cities to partner with artists to access the value of the creative sector in developing solutions to significant urban issues while supporting temporary public art projects that celebrate creativity, enhance urban identity, encourage public-private collaborations, and strengthen local economies; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Arts and Culture proposes to partner with San Antonio River Authority, Luminaria, and other artists and arts non-profits, to implement a program of temporary, pop-up activations, and festivals to engage and connect neighborhoods in all ten City Council Districts with the San Antonio river downtown; and

WHEREAS, City staff seeks the authority to submit, and accept upon award, a 2018 Public Art Challenge grant application to Bloomberg Philanthropies, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 for two years beginning late 2018 and the utilization of up to \$2,000,000.00 in 2017 Bond Funds as match; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. City staff is authorized to submit, and accept upon award, a 2018 Public Art Challenge grant application to Bloomberg Philanthropies, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 for two years beginning late 2018 and the utilization of up to \$2,000,000.00 in 2017 Bond Funds as match. City staff is authorized to execute any necessary ancillary agreements.

SECTION 2. If awarded, the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for this Ordinance shall be deposited and is authorized to be appropriated in Fund 29828000, Cultural Donations, Internal Order 82800000005, Bloomberg Donation.

SECTION 3. Funding in the amount up to \$2,000,000.00 in matching funds is available in public art funds from the 2017 General Obligation Bond Sale. Funds will be dispersed according to respective bond propositions and projects' funds availability.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten days after its passage.
