AMENDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MASTER PLAN BY REALIGNING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF TALLEY ROAD, A SECONDARY ARTERIAL TYPE A REQUIRING 86 FEET OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, BETWEEN CULEBRA ROAD (FM 471) AND CARTWRIGHT TRAIL, LOCATED IN WEST BEXAR COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio Major Thoroughfare Plan was adopted on September 21, 1978 by City Council as a component of the City of San Antonio Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on May 23, 2018 by the Planning Commission allowing all interested citizens to be heard: **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1: The Major Thoroughfare Plan, a component of the Master Plan of the City, is amended to realign a proposed segment of Talley Road, a Secondary Arterial Type A requiring 86 feet of right-of-way, between existing Culebra Road (FM 471) and Cartwright Trail. The Amendment is more particularly described in **ATTACHMENT "A,"** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.


