REGISTRY

Businesses must be 20 years or older and contribute to the history, culture, and authentic identity of San Antonio.

In return for acknowledgement as a Legacy Business, businesses will agree to perpetuate the business, its historic name and the historic service it provides.





BENEFITS

In addition to being listed online and in print and receiving a window decal, registered businesses will receive marketing and promotion opportunities.






World Heritage Area Legacy Business Grant Pilot Program

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be registered as a Legacy Business
- Must be in the World Heritage Buffer Zone
- Or 2 mile radius of Mission Concepción, San Jose, San Juan, or Espada

Façade Improvement Matching Grants Up to \$10K Landscape, signage and parking lot improvement grants

Interior Infrastructure loans






Process

- Existing historic district and design guidelines for the business location will be utilized
- WHO will provide a liaison to assist applicants and manage grant funding
- Review process will be through Office of Historic Preservation
- Improvements must comply with applicable building standards, city, state and federal requirements



Grant Process Flow





Best Practices

- Grant program is modeled on Northeast Corridor (NEC) Enhancement Matching Grant Program
- Grants can be layered with Operation Facelift Program
- Capacity building program includes information on marketing, finance, merchandising and mentorship
