A request for a change in zoning from "R-6 H AHOD" Residential Single-Family Government Hill Historic Airport Hazard Overlay District to "RM-4 H AHOD" Residential Mixed Government Hill Historic Airport Hazard Overlay District on Lot 5 and the south 51 feet of Lot 4, Block 1, NCB 1265, located at 421 Pierce Avenue. Staff recommends Approval, pending Plan Amendment. (Associated Plan Amendment 18044)
