

Item A. Operations and Maintenance

- SA River Authority shall:
 - perform normal operations and maintenance
 - be responsible for venues and special events
 - provide approval and oversight of development of adjacent property
 - fund Capital Repairs not to exceed \$50,000 per incident (two per year)
 - fund Capital Art Repairs not to exceed \$10,000 per incident (two per year)
- City and County shall:
 - fund 50% of capital repairs that exceed maximum occurrences
 - receive exclusive use for 5 special event days per year

Term is 30 Years with two 20 year renewals

Item B. Park Police Officers

- City to provide safety and security to San Pedro Creek per O&M Agreement by:
 - authorizing three full time Park Police Officers for active patrol
 - providing necessary equipment and supplies to officers
 - patrolling Phase I and II of the Creek Project
- Funds authorized from the Houston St. TIRZ will provide patrols through FY

Recommendation

- Staff recommends an Ordinance approving an Operations and Maintenance Agreement with San Antonio River Authority and Bexar County for San Pedro Creek.
- Staff recommends an Ordinance authorizing the creation of three park police officer positions to be utilized for Phases 1 and 2 of the San Pedro Creek Project funded through the Houston Street Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone #9.
