

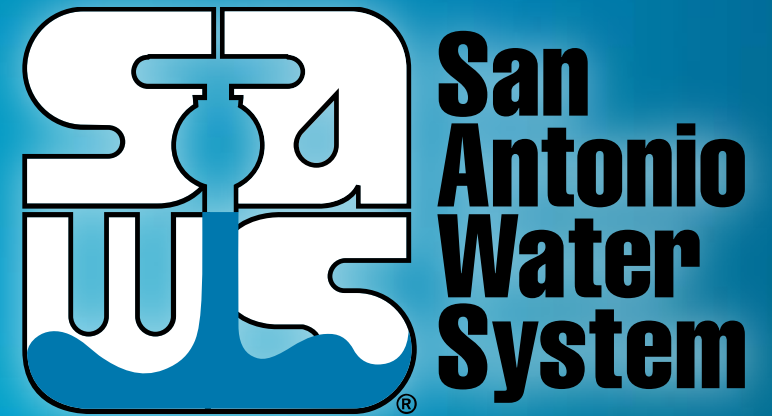

System Improvements and Upgrades

- The Central Water Integration Pipeline Project is needed to integrate water delivered to north San Antonio by Vista Ridge LLC into the existing San Antonio Water System (SAWS) distribution system
- The Project includes construction of a pump station at the point of delivery (Terminus site) and upgrades to the existing Basin, Bitters and Maltsberger pump stations along with construction of several miles of new water main ranging in size from 24-inch to 54-inch diameter
- SAWS is seeking authorization to acquire necessary property for Project completion through negotiation or condemnation
- Council must declare the Project a public necessity in order for SAWS to utilize the power of eminent domain

Est. construction cost: \$36.8M
- Segment B: 36-inch water main
Est. construction cost \$4.55M
- Est. construction period: Aug. 2018 to Dec. 2019

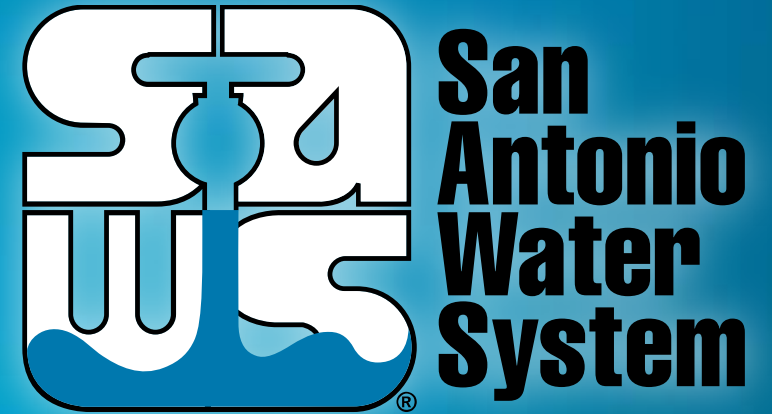
