

### CIP Funding

- Revenues
- Impact Fees
- Interest Income
- Debt
  - Tax-Exempt Revenue Bonds
  - Texas Water Development Board Tax-Exempt Bonds
    - Low interest loans
  - Tax-Exempt Commercial Paper

### Budgeted Capital Improvement Program (CIP)

\$759 M in budgeted capital expenditures for 2017 and 2018





#### SAWS Proposed Debt Transactions

- Revenue Bonds Not to Exceed \$392,000,000
  - Fixed Rate Bonds \$240,000,000
    - New Money to Fund CIP
    - Refund Tax-Exempt Commercial Paper
    - Refund Outstanding Revenue Bonds for Debt Service Savings
  - Variable Rate Bonds \$152,000,000
- Texas Water Development Board Bond (TWDB) \$10,500,000
  - Drinking Water State Revolving Fund
  - Zaramora Pump Station Improvements



#### DWSRF Application

- Application for Financial Assistance \$33,550,000
- Projects Invited to Apply:
  - Water Production Facility Upgrade Program Phase II Wurzbach
    Pump Station \$17,500,000
  - Pleasanton Road Water Main Replacement at Hume Road -\$6,900,000
  - La Rosa Pump Station Rehabilitation \$6,710,000



#### Reimbursement Resolution

- Reimbursement for expenses incurred prior to the issuance of bonds
  - 60 days prior to the issuance of the resolution through the issuance of the bonds
- Declare intent prior to the issuance of bonds
- Provides flexibility for the initial funding of projects



#### Request

- Authorization of the following:
  - Item 16A and 16B Ordinances authorizing Fixed Rate and Variable Rate Bonds not to exceed \$392,000,000
  - Item 16C Ordinance authorizing TWDB DWSRF Bond in amount not to exceed \$10,500,000
  - Item I6D Resolution authorizing a TWDB Application for Financial Assistance in an amount not to exceed \$33,550,000
  - Item 16E Resolution establishing a Reimbursement Resolution in an amount not to exceed \$33,550,000

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
