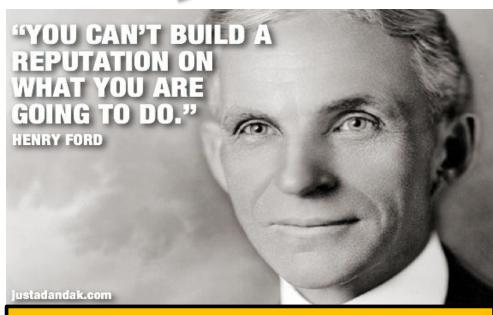

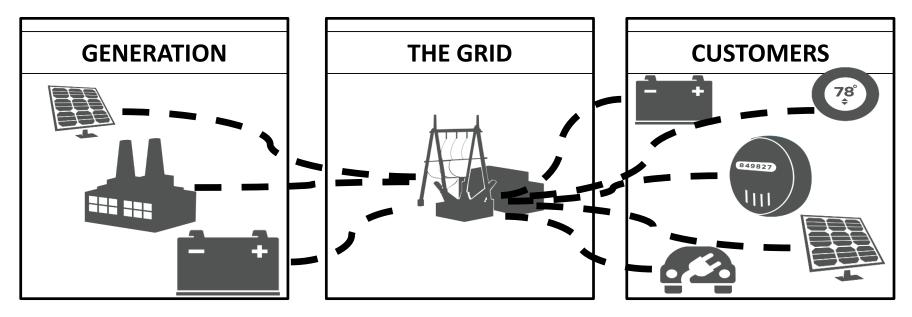

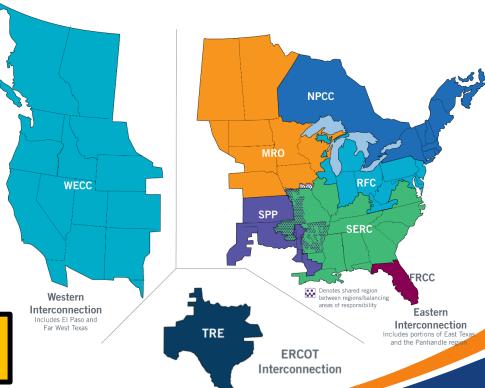
- ELECTRIC RELIABILITY COUNCIL OF TEXAS

- ERCOT's 4 Primary Responsibilities:
  - System Reliability
  - Competitive Wholesale Market
  - Open Transmission System for All Generators
  - Competitive Retail Market

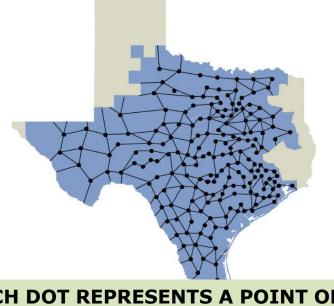

# **COMPLEX ENERGY MARKET**



- Power generators sell into the market (SUPPLY)
- Companies serving consumers buy from the market (**DEMAND**)
- ERCOT is the clearing house for SUPPLY & DEMAND



EACH DOT REPRESENTS A POINT OF SUPPLY OR DEMAND IN THE MARKET

**ERCOT** is the clearing house / our energy market

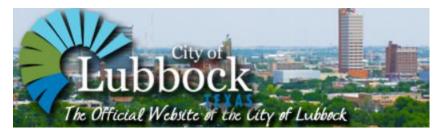

# MORE ercot COMPLEXITIES CDS



### **LUBBOCK = NEW MARKET ENTRANT / COMPETITION OPT-IN**



The city of Lubbock has asked to join Texas' deregulated electricity market, hoping to gain lower electricity prices, according to a document filed with the Public Utility Commission last week.

If approved by the PUC, Lubbock would become the first city to opt into the competitive market since Texas deregulated power 15 years ago. The move would require Lubbock to join the Electric Reliability Council of Texas, which oversees 90 percent of the state's grid, most of it serving customers with in deregulated markets.

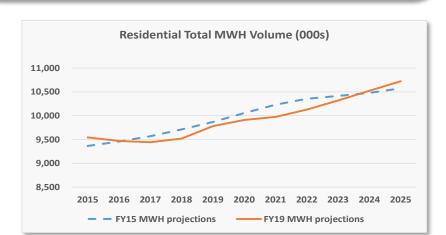

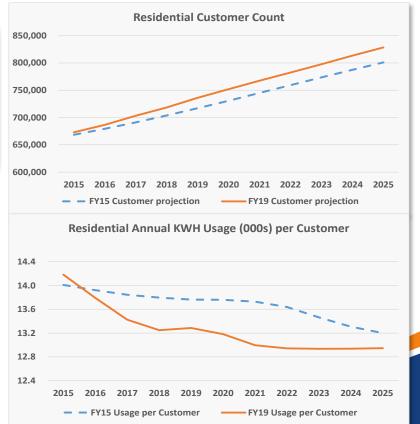

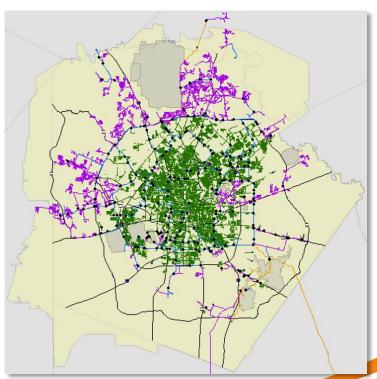

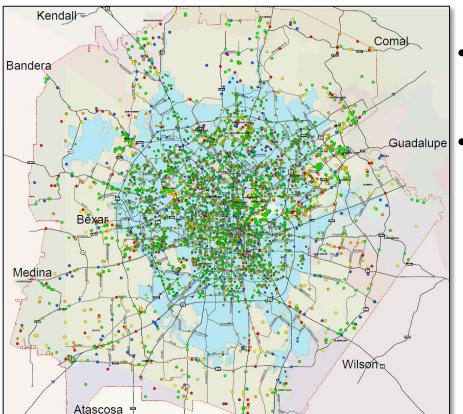
**CORRECT:** It typically costs more to connect customers in rural areas.

HOWEVER: Over time (decades), there is more work & cost incurred for customers in incorporated areas. This relates to CIVIC & MODERNIZATION INVESTMENTS.

Approximately 70% of our civic improvement work relates to COSA projects

### **MODERNIZATION PROJECTS**





- Past 5 years Spend = \$230M

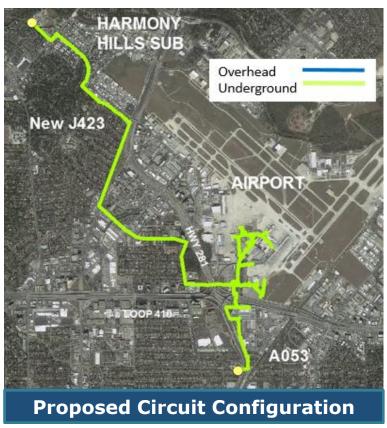

- Capital investment of ~\$13M

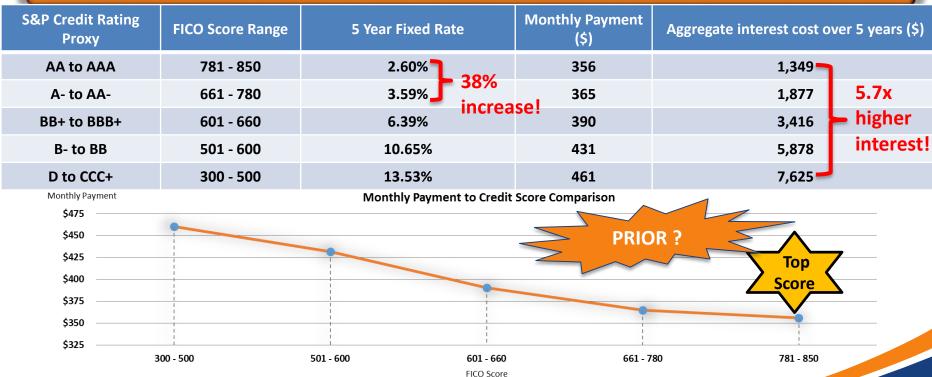

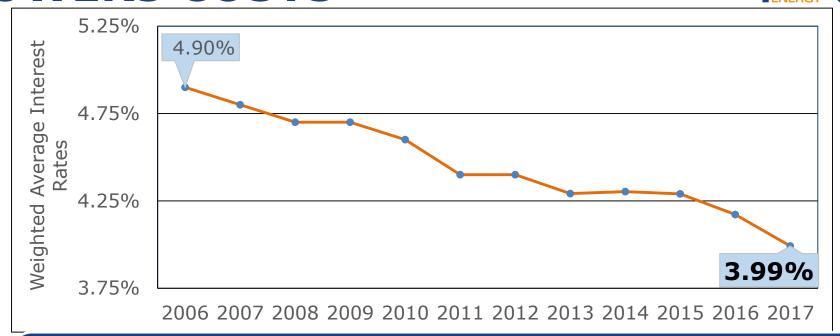
