## Background

 Metro Health seeks grant funding from the Centers for Disease Control to improve nutrition, increase physical activity, and decrease tobacco use utilizing culturally tailored interventions





### Intervention strategies

#### **Tobacco**

Collaborate with community members to promote tobacco free living in priority populations

#### **Nutrition**

Collaborate with community members to improve nutrition in priority populations

### **Physical Activity**

Collaborate with community members to connect sidewalks, paths, bike routes and transit systems



# Fiscal Impact

- The Racial and Ethnic Approaches to Community Health (REACH) is a 5 year award for up to \$3,900,625.00
- Term: Beginning September 29, 2018 September 28, 2023
- There is no impact to the General Fund in the form of a cash match
