AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$1,330,000.00: (A) JAMES LAWNMOWER, DEWINNE EQUIPMENT CO., AND JOHN H. SOROLA, INC. FOR LAWN EQUIPMENT PARTS AND SERVICE; AND (B) GEAR CLEANING SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR INSPECTION, CLEANING, ALTERATION AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR BUNKER GEAR.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with commodities and services on an annual basis for the terms of the contracts; and

SECTION 1. The following bids to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: (A) James Lawnmower, DeWinne Equipment Co., and John H. Sorola, Inc. for lawn equipment parts and service; and (B) Gear Cleaning Solutions, LLC for inspection, cleaning, alteration and repair services for bunker gear. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.
