AN ORDINANCE

**RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION AND AUTHORIZING
ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FOR A CONTINUATION
GRANT APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO
\$792,617.00 FROM THE TEXAS AUTOMOBILE
BURGLARY AND THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY
FOR THE REGIONAL AUTO CRIMES TEAM PROJECT;
APPROVING A CASH MATCH OF \$471,831.00 AND AN IN
KIND CONTRIBUTION OF \$2,662,034.00; AND
AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH
THE BEXAR COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE.**

WHEREAS, the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA) has grant funds available to fund the Regional Auto Crimes Team (ReACT); and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Police Department applied for grant funds for that purpose in an amount of \$792,617.00 to continue an existing grant, which would require a cash match of \$471,831.00 and an in kind contribution of \$2,662,034.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant, which was awarded on July 10, 2018, is for the period from September 1, 2018, to August 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, award of the grant will necessitate the execution of an agreement with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee, and the Chief of Police and his designee, are hereby authorized to apply for and accept grant funds in an amount up to \$792,617.00 from the Texas Automobile Burglary & Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA), with an in-kind match of \$2,662,034.00, a cash match not to exceed \$89,313.00 from National Insurance Crime Bureau, and a City cash match not to exceed \$471,831.00, for the Regional Auto Crimes Team (ReACT) Project for the grant period September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department. The City Manager and her designee, and the Chief of Police and his designee, are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 2. New funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount of \$792,617.00 from the ABTPA will be appropriated in said fund. A formal final budget

which will include a department specific fund, an Internal Order number, and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award. The proposed budget and personnel complement of nine (9) positions, attached hereto as **Attachment A** and **Attachment B**, respectively, are hereby approved.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, the City Manager and her designee, and the Chief of Police and his designee, are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office in connection with the ReACT Project. The agreement shall contain the same or substantially similar terms and conditions as those contained in the agreement attached hereto as **Attachment C**.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
