ORDINANCE

RENAMING "VERANO PARKWAY" TO "JAGUAR PARKWAY", LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICTS 3 AND 4.

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WHEREAS, Development Services Department received a request originating from Texas A&M University at San Antonio to rename Verano Parkway to "Jaguar Parkway" between S. Zarzamora and the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company railway line in honor of the University's mascot and to help promote Texas A&M at San Antonio campus now and into the future; and

WHEREAS, staff began implementing this request through the street renaming process as required by Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted a technical review, finding the change to conform to City Code requirements for street renaming; and

WHEREAS, staff forwarded the request to all City of San Antonio departments and outside agencies for review and no opposition was identified; and

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service approved the proposed street name change on February 12, 2018, in accordance with Chapter 35, Section 506(h)(1) of the Unified Development Code; and

WHEREAS, staff properly posted and mailed notice of this street renaming request to abutting property owners, and notice requirements for renaming of the street have been satisfied in accordance with Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was on June 19, 2018, allowing all interested persons to be heard, with no one in opposition; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on July 11, 2018, allowing all interested persons to be heard, and recommended approval; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. "Verano Parkway" located in City Council Districts 3 and 4 between S. Zarzamora and the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company railway line is hereby renamed "Jaguar Parkway". All naming requirements of Chapter 6 of the City Code have been met. The location of the street name change is more specifically depicted in Attachment I. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective 10 days after passage.
