

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A SIX-YEAR JOINT USE AGREEMENT WITH LYNXS GROUP, LLC TO ALLOW ACCESS TO AIRPORT PROPERTY FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FIBER LINES AT THE SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, Lynxs Group, LLC desires to install and maintain fiber lines to its property located at 10315 Wetmore Road, adjacent to the San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, this installation and maintenance requires access to airport-owned property; and

WHEREAS, Lynxs and their representatives shall be responsible for the procurement, installation and maintenance of the fiber lines, and will adhere to all safety standards as well as federal, state or local regulations; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the attached Joint Use Agreement required for the completion of this project; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute a Joint Use Agreement with Lynxs Group, LLC, attached as Exhibit 1, for the installation and maintenance of fiber lines to its facility located at 10315 Wetmore Road, adjacent to the San Antonio International Airport.

SECTION 2. Lynxs Group, LLC is solely responsible for all costs of construction, installation, repairs, maintenance, operation, and the like, for any property placed by Lynxs at San Antonio International Airport. There is no cost to be borne by the Airport.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
