ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR CLASS FIVE CABOVER SERVICE TRUCKS FROM RUSH TRUCK CENTER FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$391,992.00, FUNDED FROM THE FY 2018 EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND AND THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FLEET SERVICES FUND.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with four Class Five diesel-powered cabover trucks; and

WHEREAS, three trucks are replacement units and one is an additional unit to the City's fleet; and

WHEREAS, the equipment will be used by the Solid Waste Management Department for off-road mechanic support throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by Rush Truck Center for a total cost of \$391,992.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low bid from Rush Truck Center to provide the City of San Antonio with four Class Five cabover service trucks for a total cost of \$391,992.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheet is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount up to \$391,992.00 is available as part of the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, as follows:
