What is SB 1882 (2017)?

- Act relating to a school district contract to partner with an open-enrollment charter school or other eligible entity to operate a district campus
- The district may partner with two types of entities to operate the charter:
 - A State-Authorized Open-Enrollment Charter School in good standing.
 - On approval by the Commissioner, other entities. These other entities include institutions of higher education, non-profits, or government entities that have been granted a charter under Subchapter C, Chapter 12.



Why would a district want to create an 1882 Partnership?

- 1. Keep students in the district
- 2. Increased revenue for district
- 3. Possibly house site in-district school
- 4. Opportunity to set performance goals
- 5. Accountability pause for Improvement Required schools



Why would an ECE provider want to partner with the district?

- 1. Serve more families
- 2. Increased revenue for partner
- 3. Autonomy to operate



What does 1882 Board Governance look like?

- ECE does NOT have to create separate governing board
- However, ECE Board may NOT include:
 - Any school district board of trustees
 - The school district superintendent
 - Any school district personnel involved in the review, approval, monitoring, or renewal of the Subchapter C charter or performance contract.



What are the Goals of the Edgewood 1882 Partnership ?

- 1. To launch an 1882 Pre-K Partnership by fall of 2019 with *unanimous* board approval.
- 2. To secure additional funding for launch through TEA School Action Fund
- **3. Long-Term Goal:** To scale ECE either by increasing enrollment or adding additional sites by 2020
- 4. Larger Goal for District: To have Pre-K students feed into Priority of Focus school(s) to improve student outcomes of school(s)
- Larger Goal for State: To decrease the overall district and state number of D and F campuses and increase the amount of A and B campuses



What is our <u>GRPI</u> (Goals, Roles, Processes, Interpersonal)?





Considerations for Pre-K 4 SA

- 1. Determine if there are potential partnerships with additional ISDs in San Antonio
- 2. Work with MAYA to apply for a School Action Fund planning or implementation grant **by February 2019**
- 3. Build the partnerships as a key component to serve all eligible Pre-K students in San Antonio
