SUMMARY

- Provides American Sign Language (ASL)
 Emergency Alert System
- First year cost— \$88,164.00
- Optional renewal- annual cost \$78,164.00







DEAF LINK

- Founded in 2002 and based in San Antonio, TX
- Provides services for persons with sensory disabilities
- Operates in 18 states
- Cities include Fort Worth, Oklahoma City, Long Beach





SCOPE OF SERVICES

The ASL Emergency Alert System will include:

- Website for deaf and hard of hearing to register with the system
- Tracking of user registration volume
- ASL public service announcement (PSA) videos
- Alerts delivered in ASL
