WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance Number 2013-05-30-0380, passed and approved on May 30, 2013, the City Council approved the re-establishment of the Downtown Public Improvement District ("PID") through September 30, 2023 pursuant to the Public Improvement District Assessment Act, Local Government Code, Chapter 372; and

WHEREAS, the PID is a means through which property owners in the District can self-fund additional improvements and services to enhance the appearance and safety of the San Antonio downtown area; and

WHEREAS, the current Amended and Restated Contract for Improvements and/or Services in the San Antonio Public Improvement District with Centro Public Improvement District was authorized an approved by City Council on September 5, 2013, by the passage of Ordinance Number 2013-09-05-0613; and

WHEREAS, under the proposed Second Amended and Restated Contract for Improvements and/or Services in the San Antonio Public Improvement District ("Second Amended and Restated Contract") with the Centro Public Improvement District ("Centro"), Centro will continue to supplement City services by providing maintenance, beautification and landscaping, hospitality ambassador services, outreach and security services, marketing and promotion of the District, community events and programs, economic development activities, including business recruitment and retention activities, project management, planning and research initiatives and capital projects and special project services; and
