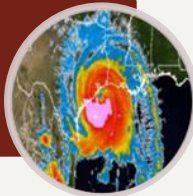


# Background

## Public Health Threats are on the rise

- The intensity, frequency, and duration of North Atlantic hurricanes have increased since the 1980's
- Gulf coast evacuation roads lead to S.A.

### Extreme Flooding & Hurricanes



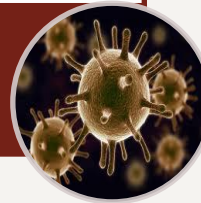
- Threats continue to evolve significantly since 9/11

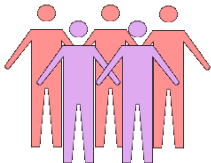

# Fiscal Impact

---

- In FY2017, Angel Staffing, Inc. and Stability Staffing & Consulting, LLC provided over 4,000 volunteer hours
- Funding Amount Total: Up to \$750,000.00
  - Angel Staffing, Inc.: \$375,000.00
  - Stability Staffing & Consulting, LLC: \$375,000.00
- Term: September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2020
  - With two, 1-year renewals
- There is no impact to the General Fund
