Emergency Service Districts


Created under state law and approved by voters to provide emergency services in unincorporated areas of the County



Emergency Service Districts

Must receive City's approval if the ESD is located within the ETJ

City negotiated certain conditions for approval



ESD No. 10 - Agreement


- Cannot incur debt over \$20,000 without consent

- Must ensure equipment compatibility

- Must enter into mutual aid agreements

ESD No. 10 - Request

ESD requesting consent to incur \$7.545 million in debt to implement a 5-year capital improvement plan



Implications to COSA

City would be responsible for a pro-rata share of indebtedness if it annexes territory within the ESD

No plans to annex territory within ESD No. 10

Staff Review

City Planning, Fire and Finance staff reviewed request for impact to the City







Recommendation

Staff recommends providing consent to ESD No. 10 to incur debt of up to \$7,545,000
