

A RESOLUTION 2018-08-30-0039R

**CONSENTING TO THE REQUEST OF BEXAR
COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #7,
LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL
JURISDICTION TO INCUR DEBT NOT TO EXCEED
\$10,000,000.00 FOR RENOVATIONS TO EXISTING
STATIONS AND EQUIPMENT.**

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2016, through Ordinance No. 2006-03-02-0264, City Council approved an agreement with Bexar County, consenting to an election calling for the creation of Emergency Service District #7 (ESD #7) within the City's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction, so that the ESD #7 may provide fire suppression and emergency medical services to individuals residing within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, an election was held, and ESD #7, in northwestern Bexar County, was created; and

WHEREAS, the agreement contained conditions imposed on ESD #7, including the requirement for the district to seek the consent of the City when incurring debt exceeding \$20,000.00; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2015, City Council approved Resolution 2015-06-18-45R allowing ESD No. 7 to incur debt in the amount of up to \$10,000,000.00 for renovations and replacement of equipment and the construction of a new fire station to serve the residents of the district; and

WHEREAS, the district has asked for the City's consent for it to secure a loan not to exceed the amount of \$10,000,000.00 renovations to existing stations and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City is not required to assume any of the debt if the district defaults on the loan, but is required by state law to pay the district its pro-rata share of the debt if the City annexes all or part of the district before the debt is repaid; and

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the request and recommends that consent be granted;
NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. Consent is hereby granted for ESD #7, in accordance with the terms of Texas Health & Safety Code, Chapter 775 and the Agreement for Approval of ESD #7, for the district to incur debt not to exceed \$10,000,000.00, for the purpose of purchasing fire fighting equipment for use within the district's boundaries.


