ORDINANCE

APPROVING A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT FOR GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM SOFTWARE LICENSES, SUPPORT, MAINTENANCE AND TRAINING WITH ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS RESEARCH INSTITUTE, INC., FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$625,000.00, THE FIRST YEAR OF WHICH IS FUNDED THROUGH THE ADOPTED FISCAL YEAR 2019 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES DEPARTMENT FUND BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, this Ordinance considers an agreement with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. ("ESRI") to provide the Information Technology Services Department ("ITSD") with geographic information system ("GIS") software licenses, support, maintenance and training to develop GIS applications and meet the growing demands for GIS services, with a term commencing on October 19, 2018 and expiring on October 18, 2021, unless terminated earlier; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement allows ITSD to support the GIS business needs for all City of San Antonio departments, as well as Open Government initiatives, including GIS software, software support, map production, data management, database administration, web development, application interfacing and training, and gives ITSD the licensing to fully support desktop and web based GIS business needs across a common platform and software suite; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement also enrolls the City in an active business relationship with ESRI, called the ESRI Enterprise Advantage Program, which, through collaboration, will lead to the development of a plan for implementing location strategies that match GIS Services to departmental and City goals and includes access to select support, training and consulting services; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The terms and conditions of a three-year agreement for Geographic Information Software licenses, support, maintenance and training with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., in an annual amount of \$625,000.00, are authorized and approved. The City manager, or her designee, is authorized to sign the Agreement. A copy of the Agreement, previously executed by ESRI, is attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$625,000.00 for this Ordinance was approved in the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget in Fund 74001000, Cost Center 903050001 and General Ledger 5201047.

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SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to ESRI and shall be encumbered with a purchase order. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2019 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term period of this Agreement approved by City Council.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten days after its passage.
