

AN ORDINANCE 2018-10-04-0784

APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT OF A LAWSUIT STYLED JESSICA LAILSON, ET AL. VS. CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, CAUSE NUMBER 2017-CI-12909, PENDING IN 407TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$111,000.00

WHEREAS, Jessica Lailson is seeking damages individually and as next of friend of Audrey Vasquez as a result of a motor vehicle accident that occurred on March 28, 2016 on Bandera Road involving a San Antonio Police Department vehicle and a private vehicle operated by Jessica Lailson; and

WHEREAS, although the City of San Antonio has vigorously contested this matter, it is in the City's best interest to settle this matter to avoid the uncertainties and risks associated with further litigation; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached a mutual agreement to settle the claims of Jessica Lailson individually and as next of friend of Audrey Vasquez for the amount of \$111,000.00 payable from the Self-Insurance Liability Fund subject to City Council approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$111,000.00 is authorized to be paid from Fund 75001000, Insurance Reserve Fund, General Ledger 5402530 General Liability Claims, Cost Center 7509020001 Risk Management-Liability, and is authorized to be made payable as follows: \$103,000.00 will be paid to plaintiff Jessica Lailson, Individually, and her attorney of record; and \$8,000.00 will be paid to plaintiff Jessica Lailson as next of friend of Ashley Vasquez and her attorney of record as settlement of Cause Number 2017-CI-12909 styled Jessica Lailson, et al. v. City of San Antonio.


SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


