AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TELOS IDENTITY MANAGEMENT SOLUTIONS LLC, DBA TELOS ID, TO EXTEND THE CONTRACT TERM TO APRIL 12, 2024 AND INCREASE THE CONTRACT VALUE IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$506,621.32 FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$1,133,621.32 FOR DESIGNATED AVIATION CHANNELING SERVICES FOR THE SAN ANTONIO AIRPORT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS in November of 2013 the City entered into a Professional Services Agreement for Designated Aviation Channeling Services with Telos Identity Management Solutions LLC; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to extend this contract through April 12, 2014 and increase the contract value in the amount not to exceed \$506,621.32 for a total contract amount of \$1,133,621.32; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with Telos Identity Management Solutions, LLC is approved. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute the amendment, a copy of which is set out in **Exhibit 1**.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$165,042.00 for this ordinance is contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget for Fund 51001000, Cost Center 330504004 and General Ledger 5201040.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Telos Identity Management Solutions LLC. and should be encumbered with a purchase order. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2019 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term period of this contract approved by City Council.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR DESIGNATED AVIATION CHANNELING SERVICES AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

This Amendment (hereinafter called the "Amendment") to the Professional Services Agreement for Designated Aviation Channeling Services at San Antonio International Airport is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio (herein called the "City"), a Texas municipal corporation, acting by and through its City Manager, and Telos Identity Management Solutions, LLC (hereinafter called "Consultant"), acting by and through its duly authorized corporate representative, as set out below. WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2013, the City and Consultant entered into a Professional Services Agreement for Designated Aviation Channeling Services at San Antonio International Airport. (hereinafter called the "Agreement") pursuant to Ordinance No. 2013-11-21-0808; and

WHEREAS, that Agreement expires on December 12, 2018; and

WHEREAS, The San Antonio International Airport is required by Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations to ensure applicants for identification badges for the Airport meet the specified requirements including passing a Criminal History Records Check (CHRC) and Security Threat Assessment (STA); and

WHEREAS, City desires Consultant to extend the contract term by Five (5) years and Four (4) months, and increase the contract value by \$506,621.32 such that Consultant can provide continued support associated with security screening of airport employees and applicants; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, covenants, agreements and demises herein contained, and in consideration of other good and valuable consideration, each to the other given, the sufficiency and receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, the Agreement entered into by and between the City and the Consultant is amended as follows:

1. Section II--Period of Service. The term of the Agreement is hereby extended for an additional term of Five (5) years and Four (4) months, expiring on April 12, 2024.

2. Section V--Compensation. The not to exceed fee amount in Article 5.2 of the Agreement is hereby increased by \$506.621.32. The fee shall be paid to Consultant in accordance with the terms of the Agreement pursuant to the following schedule:
