

AN ORDINANCE **2018-10-18-0830**

**RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION AND AUTHORIZING
ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN AN AMOUNT OF
\$228,260.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE,
OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE
ASSISTANCE FOR THE FY 2018 INTELLECTUAL
PROPERTY ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM: PROTECTING
PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND THE ECONOMY FROM
COUNTERFEIT GOODS AND PRODUCT PIRACY
GRANT.**

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WHEREAS, on June 7, 2018, the San Antonio Police Department submitted a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Intellectual Property Enforcement Program: Protecting Public Health, Safety, and the Economy from Counterfeit Goods and Product Piracy Grant; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Police Department was notified on September 21, 2018, that it had been awarded \$228,260.00 in grant funds to assist in criminal investigation, prosecution, prevention, and education as it relates to intellectual property enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the grant is for the period from October 1, 2018, to September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, no matching contribution on the part of the City is required; **NOW
THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The submission of the grant application by the San Antonio Police Department is hereby approved and The City Manager or her designee, or the Chief of Police or his designee is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$228,260.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the Intellectual Property Enforcement Program for the grant period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2020. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department.

SECTION 2. Upon acceptance of the award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created for the grant funds in an amount up to \$228,260.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance to be appropriated in said fund. A formal final budget which will include a department specific fund, an Internal Order number, and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.


SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4 This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
