

ORDINANCE 2018-10-18-0837

AWARDING A TASK ORDER CONTRACT FOR TRAFFIC ENGINEERING PROJECTS PACKAGE 2 TO E-Z BEL CONSTRUCTION, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,350,944.00 FOR TRAFFIC ENGINEERING AND SAFETY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS LOCATED CITYWIDE.

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WHEREAS, Transportation & Capital Improvements (TCI) is responsible for implementing various traffic engineering and safety construction projects throughout the City and this contract will be utilized to complete projects to include bike lanes, pedestrian refuge islands, multi-use paths, and any other related work through the issuance of task orders; and

WHEREAS, the City received one bid in response to an invitation for bid released in July 2018; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$2,350,944; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$2,350,944 for the 2018-2019 Task Order Contract for Traffic Engineering Projects Package 2, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever comes first.


SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment not to exceed \$2,350,944.00 for projects located citywide is authorized to with E-Z Bel Construction, LLC. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2019 budget and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.




