AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF LINE-OF-DUTY INJURY LEAVE FOR SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT FIRE ENGINEER SHODY HENSHAW.

WHEREAS, section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a firefighter injured in the line of duty is entitled to line-of-duty injury leave with full pay for a period to commensurate with the injury and not to exceed one year; and

WHEREAS, section 143.073 also provides that a municipality's governing body may extend the line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio Fire Department Fire Engineer Shody Henshaw was injured in the line of duty on December 23, 2015, and, as a result, required leave in excess of one year to address said injury; and

WHEREAS, Fire Engineer Henshaw is requesting an extension of line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year for the period December 23, 2016, to January 22, 2017 and April 11, 2017 to January 11, 2018; and

WHEREAS, approving the requested extension will restore 1,700 hours of accrued leave to Fire Engineer Douglas; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. An extension beyond one year of San Antonio Fire Department Fire Engineer Henshaw's line-of-duty injury leave for the period December 23, 2016 to January 22, 2017 and April 11, 2017 to January 11, 2018, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
