ORDINANCE 2018-11-15-0907

AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO INDUSTRIAL CONSTRUCTION CO. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$206,054.00 FOR THE HARLANDALE PARK BASKETBALL CANOPY PROJECT, A 2017-2022 BOND FUNDED PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 3.

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WHEREAS, the 2017-2022 Bond Program included \$350,000.00 for funding Harlandale Park improvements; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance awards a construction contract for the installation of a preengineered metal canopy over the existing basketball court and construction of a bike rack and drinking fountain; and

WHEREAS, the City opened bids in September 2018 and seven (7) bids were received; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by Industrial Construction Co. in an amount not to exceed \$206,054.00 for the Harlandale Park Basketball Canopy Project; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid by Industrial Construction Co. in an amount not to exceed \$206,054.00 for the Harlandale Park Basketball Canopy Project is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever comes first.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of \$206,054.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01667, Harlandale Park 2017, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Industrial Construction Co., for construction services.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
