ORDINANCE

AWARDING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO SAN ANTONIO CONCEPTS CONSTRUCTION, LLC FOR THE 2018 - 2019 CONCRETE PAVEMENT & FLATWORK TASK ORDER CONTRACT PACKAGE 16 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,593,114.30 INCLUDING ADDITIVE ALTERNATE #1, OF WHICH \$168,650.00 WILL BE REIMBURSED BY SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEM (SAWS) AND \$1,000.00 WILL BE REIMBURSED BY CPS ENERGY FOR NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS TO EXISTING INFRASTRUCTURE.

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WHEREAS, with the FY 2019 Budget, City Council approved the FY 2019 Street Maintenance Program (SMP) at \$110 million to complete the entire SMP comprised of both in-house and contractual street maintenance projects; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance awards a task order construction contract for concrete pavement and flatwork; and

WHEREAS, the City opened bids in August 2018 and five (5) bids were received; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by San Antonio Concepts Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$4,593,114.30 for the 2018 - 2019 Concrete Pavement & Flatwork Task Order Contract Package 16; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid by San Antonio Concepts Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$4,593,114.30, including additive alternate #1, for the 2018 - 2019 Concrete Pavement & Flatwork Task Order Contract Package 16, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever comes first.

SECTION 2. Funding for this Ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets and is included in the FY 2019 - 2023 Capital Improvements Program.
