This contract will provide the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) with the purchase of additional functionality and maintenance for continued access and support to the data management system already in place. This service is used for permitting/licensing and health inspections of food establishments, daycare centers, public swimming pools and other areas frequented by the public. SAMHD will be augmenting the current data management system to include functionality for tracking information related to the newly added Tobacco 21 program.

These items are being purchased as Sole Source according to the provisions of Texas Statutes Local Government Code 252.022.07. No other source can supply the items listed nor can any comparable item fulfill the same requirements.
