ORDINANCE 2018-11-29-0939

ACQUIRING A 3.3 ACRE TRACT OF LAND AT 224 WEST QUILL DRIVE FOR USE AS A NEIGHBORHOOD PARK IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 FOR A TOTAL PURCHASE PRICE OF \$300,000.00 FUNDED WITH CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATIONS AND TAX NOTES IN THE FY 2019 ADOPTED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, the proposed property acquisition will be utilized for the future development of West Quill Park as a neighborhood park in Council District 7; and

WHEREAS, this acquisition is consistent with the policies outlined in the SA Tomorrow Comprehensive Plan which recommends increasing the number and quality of parks to ensure a more equitable distribution of parks and recreation opportunities; and

WHEREAS, discussions began with the property owner, District 7 Council Office and the Parks and Recreation Department during the summer of 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department has worked closely with the property owner and Council Office to address the desire for additional park land in the community; and

WHEREAS, this property is pedestrian accessible along West Quill Drive and will provide an opportunity to add public parkland in an underserved area; and

WHEREAS, the nearest neighborhood park is not accessible by foot to the residents of the Woodlawn Hills neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the property will be acquired and developed using \$500,000.00 in Certificate of Obligation funds and Tax Notes appropriated in the approved FY 2019-2024 Adopted Annual Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, the funds will utilize \$300,000.00 for the actual purchase of the property and \$2,937.50 for the associated closing costs; and

WHEREAS, remaining funds will be utilized for a first phase of improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Woodlawn Hills Neighborhood Association supports the acquisition of this property for a neighborhood park; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of Parks and Recreation Department or his designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute contracts for the acquisition

or approximately 3.3 acre tract of land located at 224 West Quill Drive. The property will be utilized as a future neighborhood park in Council District 7. Maps of the approximate areas of land to be acquired are attached as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of \$302,937.50 in SAP Fund 43099000, Certificates Of Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 26-00689, W Quill Land Acquisition & Development, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to selected title company, for due diligence and closing costs on a 3.3 acre tract of privately owned real property located in NCB 11520 in Council District 7 in Bexar County, Texas.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
