## AN ORDINANCE 2018 - 11 - 29 - 0941

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE STD STAFF SUPPORT PROGRAM GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,070,509.00 FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2019 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2019, AND A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) receives an award from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) through the Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Staff Support Program grant annually; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant provides disease investigation and counseling to control and prevent the spread of sexually transmitted diseases such as syphilis, HIV, Gonorrhea, and Chlamydia; and

**WHEREAS**, through the STD Staff Support Program grant, Metro Health's STD/HIV Prevention Program is able to provide diagnosis, treatment, and partner notification services to residents in San Antonio and Bexar County; and

**WHEREAS**, Metro Health requests City Council ratify the submission of grant application documents, authorize the acceptance of funds from the DSHS for the STD Staff Support Program and authorize a personnel complement; **NOW THEREFORE:** 

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The submission of the grant application to the Texas Department of State Health Services is hereby ratified. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) or her designee is authorized to accept grant funds for the Sexually Transmitted Disease Staff Support Program grant in an amount not to exceed \$2,070,509.00 for the period from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. A copy of the grant application which is incorporated herein for all purposes is on file with Metro Health.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or her designee, is authorized to execute any and all necessary documents and grant contracts to effectuate the applications and acceptance of the grants referenced in Section 1 of this ordinance. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or her designee, is further authorized to execute contract amendments pertaining to these contracts in the following instances a) carry-over funds, when ascertained and approved by the funding agency through a revised notice of award; b) line item budget revisions authorized by the funding agency; c) modifications to the performance measures authorized by the funding agency and listed in the contracts so long as the terms of the amendment stay within the general

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parameters of the intent of the grant; d) no cost extensions; e) amendments which will provide supplemental grant funds to a grant by the funding agency in an amount up to 20% of the total amount initially awarded to the grant; f) reimbursement increases of administrative funds for each participant served; g) amendments funding one time equipment purchases or defined program services; and h) changes in state regulations mandated by the funding agency.

**SECTION 3.** Upon acceptance of the award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created for the grant funds in an amount up to \$2,070,509.00 from DSHS to be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books. A formal final budget which will include a department specific fund, an Internal Order number, and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
