AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$30,914 FROM THE SOUTHWEST TEXAS REGIONAL ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR TRAUMA FOR USE BY THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR GOODS AND SERVICES; AND APPROVING A PROGRAM BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, the Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council for Trauma (STRAC) has informed the San Antonio Fire Department (SAFD) of the award of a grant to SAFD in an amount up to \$30,914 of FY 19 EMS Traumas Care System (a.k.a. County 911) funds to be used by SAFD for eligible goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the eligible goods and services for which the grant funds will be used by SAFD include supplies, operational expenses, education and training, equipment, vehicles, and/or communications equipment; and

WHEREAS, no cash or in-kind matching contributions are required in connection with this grant; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A grant to SAFD in an amount up to \$30,914 from STRAC, to be used by SAFD for eligible goods and services including supplies, operational expenses, education and training, equipment, vehicles, and/or communications equipment for FY 2019, is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. A copy of a letter from STRAC to SAFD regarding this grant and setting forth certain specifics regarding the use of the grant funds is attached hereto as **Attachment 1** and made a part hereof for all purposes. The City Manager or her designee, or the Fire Chief or his designee, are each hereby authorized to execute any and all additional documents necessary to effectuate and evidence the acceptance of the grant and/or perform the programs for which the grant funds will be used, without further action by the City Council.

SECTION 3. *Insert Fiscal Language*.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer ("DCFO"), City of San Antonio. The DCFO may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund

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Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
