ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO EXECUTE A SPORTS LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH MCALLISTER PARK LITTLE LEAGUE FOR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE LOWER BASEBALL FIELDS AT MCALLISTER PARK FOR A FIVE (5) YEAR TERM.

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WHEREAS, McAllister Park Little League has established a community presence since 1977; and

WHEREAS, the league utilizes the lower baseball complex at McAllister Park to provide organized youth sports activities year round; the league served over 800 area youth in 2017; and

WHEREAS, a new Sports License Agreement is proposed to commence upon Council approval and expire October 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent, the league shall be responsible for the operations and maintenance of the lower baseball complex at McAllister Park; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the league will be permitted to rent fields and operate concessions with proceeds benefitting their program and to offset the cost of operations and maintenance; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a Sports License Agreement with McAllister Park Little League for operations and maintenance of the lower baseball fields at McAllister Park for a five (5) year term. A copy of the License Agreement in substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. No Fiscal Impact.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund

Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
