

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF A MASTER INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BEXAR COUNTY FOR COOPERATIVE PURCHASING, CRIME LAB, HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX COLLECTION, JURY POOL, LIBRARY, PLATTING, AND THE TRUANCY CASE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM WITH THE OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM FOR UP TO FOUR ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS.

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WHEREAS, in the interest of efficiency and effective provision of services, for years the City and Bexar County ("County") have entered into interlocal agreements related to numerous services, including cooperative purchasing, Crime Lab, Hotel Occupancy Tax Collection, Jury Pool, Library, Platting, and the Truancy Case Management Program ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, this proposed Master Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") continues the practice of consolidating interlocal agreements between the City and County for Services into one document;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The terms and conditions of a one-year Master Interlocal Agreement with Bexar County, with four one-year extensions, are authorized and approved. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute the Agreement. A copy of the Agreement in substantially final form, is attached and incorporated in this Ordinance for all purposes as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this Ordinance will be deposited and appropriated as part of the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget.

SECTION 3. Funding for this Ordinance has been appropriated as part of the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
