## **ORDINANCE**

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CNG ENGINEERING, PLLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$445,000.00 FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES RELATED TO THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE COMMERCIAL FEDERAL INSPECTION STATION FACILITY PROJECT AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; APPROPRIATING FUNDING FROM THE AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT AND CONTINGENCY FUNDS; AND AMENDING THE FY 2019 - FY 2024 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute an amendment to the professional services agreement with CNG Engineering, PLLC in an amount not to exceed \$445,000.00 for additional design and construction administration services for the Expansion of the Commercial Federal Inspection Station Facility (FIS) project at the San Antonio International Airport.
