AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DR. FRETORRY ROGERS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$100,000.00 TO PROVIDE IN-HOUSE SURGICAL SERVICES FOR A TERM OF JANUARY, 1, 2019 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2019 WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR THREE ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio ("City") recognizes that sterilizing pets through spay/neuter surgeries is key in controlling the stray and roaming animal population in San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, the City's Animal Care Services Department ("ACS") operates a clinic seven days a week to maintain the shelter health of pets and to prepare pets via spay/neuter and specialized surgeries for live release placement through adoption or transfer to rescue groups; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that in Fiscal Year 2019 the City will financially support approximately 44,000-45,000 free or low-cost animal care surgeries to be performed at local spay/neuter clinics, or the ACS main adoption center by staff and contract veterinarians; and

WHEREAS, contract veterinarians aide ACS veterinary staff in performing these valuable services; and

WHEREAS, retaining the services of high-volume surgery providers allows ACS to maintain maximum daily operations of performing between 17,000 and 19,000 spay/neuter and specialized surgeries inhouse annually by our Staff and Contract Veterinary team; and

WHEREAS, the City issued an on-going Request for Application in August 2017 soliciting applications for qualified and experienced candidates for Contract Veterinarians at ACS; and

WHEREAS, for this contract, the Small Business Economic Development ("SBEDA") Ordinance requirements were waived due to no certified Small, Minority, Women, and Veteran Owned Business Enterprise registered within the program; and

WHEREAS, due diligence was done by ACS staff ensuring that all veterinarians are currently licensed to practice Veterinary Medicine in the State of Texas and

WHEREAS, Dr. Frettory Rogers was selected to provide veterinary in-house surgical services; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the Animal Care Services Department or his designee is authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Dr.

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Fretorry Rogers, in an amount up to \$100,000.00 to provide in-house surgical services for a term of January, 1, 2019 through September 30, 2019 with the option to renew for three additional one-year terms. A copy of the contract, in substantially final form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I.**

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$100,000.00 is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 3703020001 and General Ledger 5202020 as part of the FY 2019 Budget.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Dr. Fretorry Rogers to provide veterinary in-house surgical services and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
