## **ORDINANCE**

**ORDINANCE APPROVING CONTRACT WITH** A **INJURY** MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATION, INC. TO PROVIDE MEDICAL **SERVICES THROUGH** CONTAINMENT **WORKERS'** COMPENSATION HEALTH CARE NETWORK, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 1305 OF THE TEXAS INSURANCE CODE, FOR THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, FOR A THREE YEAR TERM BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2019 WITH TWO ADDITIONAL ONE YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS, FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$455,000, FUNDED FROM THE SELF-INSURANCE WORKERS' COMPENSATION FUND.

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WHEREAS, the City released a Request for Proposals (RFP) to provide the City with provide medical cost containment services through a Workers' Compensation Health Care Network (HCN) in accordance with chapter 1305 of the Texas Insurance Code; and

WHEREAS, one response was received and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends Injury Management Organization, Inc. for award of this contract; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** Injury Management Organization, Inc. is hereby selected to provide medical cost containment services through a Workers' Compensation Health Care Network (HCN) in accordance with chapter 1305 of the Texas Insurance Code, as described in the attached contract for an estimated annual cos of \$455,000.00. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the Office of Risk Management, is hereby authorized to execute the contract for said services, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit I**. The terms of said contract are hereby approved. This contract may be renewed and extended for two additional, successive one-year renewal periods on the same terms and conditions, subject to funding by the City Council, and extended as otherwise provided within the contract. So long as funding is provided for in the budget, no further City Council action shall be required to effect the renewals and/or extensions, which may be executed by the City Manager, the City Manager's designee, or the Director of the Office of Risk Management.

**SECTION 2.** Funding for this Ordinance in the amount up to \$265,300.00 is available in Fund 75003000, Cost Center 7501010001 and General Ledger 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget. Additional funding is contingent upon City Council approval of subsequent budgets that fall within the term length of this contract.

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**SECTION 3.** Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Injury Management Organization, Inc. (IMO) to provide medical cost containment services through 1305 Worker's Compensation Health Care Network (HSN).

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
