ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN ADVANCED FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE **TEXAS** DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT). AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12.166.00 PAYABLE TO TXDOT, AND ACCEPTING AN AMOUNT NOT \$968,000.00 TO EXCEED FROM TXDOT RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION COSTS FOR THE JUDSON ROAD SIDEWALKS PROJECT, AN ADVANCED TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT AND FEDERALLY FUNDED PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10.

WHEREAS, this project will provide sidewalks, curbs, accessibility ramps, and mill and overlay of pavement along the west side of Judson Road from Independence Avenue to Interstate 35; and

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WHEREAS, this project was selected for funding through the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and will be managed by the City and receive federal funds administered through TxDOT; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of the TIP, the City, as the local agency, is responsible for 20% of the construction cost with the remaining 80% being provided federally through TxDOT; and

WHEREAS, this Advanced Funding Agreement with TxDOT will allow construction-related project costs to qualify for federal cost sharing up to the federally approved amount not to exceed \$968,000.00, and the City will be responsible for the remaining cost of \$242,000.00 00 which amount is available and included in the FY 2017 - FY 2022 Capital Improvements Program; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the execution of an Advanced Funding Agreement between the City of San Antonio and TxDOT in the amount not to exceed \$12,166.00 to TxDOT and accepting reimbursement in the not to exceed amount of \$968,000.00 from TxDOT related to construction costs for the Judson Road Sidewalks Project; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the Transportation and Capital Improvements Department or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for payment in the amount not to exceed \$12,166.00 to TxDOT for administrative oversight of federal funds and accepting reimbursement in the amount not to exceed \$968,000.00 from TxDOT related to construction

costs for the Judson Road Sidewalks Project. A copy of the agreement is substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. RESERVED FOR FISCAL LANGUAGE.
