

INTERLOCAL COOPERATION CONTRACT

I. CONTRACTING PARTIES AND AUTHORITY

The Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the City of San Antonio (COSA) are contracting under the authority of Texas Government Code Chapter 791 (the Interlocal Cooperation Act).

DPS certifies that it has the authority to contract for the services agreed upon by the authority granted in Texas Government Code Chapter 411.

COSA certifies that it has the authority to contract for the services agreed upon by the authority granted in Ordinance No. _____, passed and approved by San Antonio City Council on January 31, 2019.

II. STATEMENT OF SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED

COSA will continue to provide all current Texas Anti-Gang grant (TAG) services and goods it provides during the transition to DPS. COSA will invoice DPS the monthly reimbursable amount for these costs.

DPS will pay COSA the monthly reimbursable amount based on COSA's costs for these TAG services and goods. During the transition, DPS may assume real property, IT, and equipment responsibilities, and other items as coordinated between the parties.

III. CONTRACT AMOUNT and BASIS FOR CALCULATING COSTS

The total amount of this contract will not exceed \$970,890 or the entire Texas Anti-Gang Program grant award amount awarded to DPS, with the addition of any future amounts awarded to DPS under the Texas Anti-Gang Program grant during the term of this contract.

IV. TERM OF CONTRACT and AMENDMENTS

This contract is effective on the date of the last party to sign and will terminate on 8/31/20, or upon written request of either party with 30 calendar days' written notice, whichever occurs earlier. This contract may only be amended or extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, but it may not be extended more than six months after the expiration date.

V. NOTICE

The respective party will provide any required notice as noted in this section. Either party may change its information in this section by giving the other party written notice and the date upon which the change will become effective.
