A RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO INITIATE A ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY CHANGE TO DESIGNATE 219 N. SAN MARCOS, LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 5, AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK AND TO WAIVE APPLICATION FEES TOTALING \$842.70

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WHEREAS, the City's historic preservation program is designed to preserve, protect, and enhance historically, culturally, architecturally, and archaeologically significant sites and structures which impart a distinct aspect to the city and serve as visible reminders of the city's culture and heritage; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2018, the Office of Historic Preservation received an application requesting demolition of the commercial structure located 219 N. San Marcos; and

WHEREAS, the structure at 219 N. San Marcos is a double-height, single-story modified 1920s commercial building at the corner of N. San Marcos and W. Travis streets; and

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2018, Sarah Gould, representing the Westside Preservation Alliance and the Esperanza Peace and Justice Center submitted to the Office of Historic Preservation a request for review of historic significance for the structure located at 219 N. San Marcos in the Prospect Hill neighborhood of District 5; and

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2018, the Historic Design Review Commission identified the structure at 219 N. San Marcos, as having Historic Significance; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Historic Preservation requests City Council to proceed with the Historic Landmark designation of 219 N. San Marcos and waive the application fees; and

WHEREAS, City Council agrees to initiate a change to the zoning boundary of the property to a zoning compatible with the current use and the surrounding area in accordance with Texas Government Code Chapter 211 and City Code of San Antonio, Texas, Chapter 35, Unified Development Code Article III; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. City Council hereby directs city staff to initiate a change in the zoning boundary of the property located at 219 N. San Marcos, San Antonio, Texas 78207 for Historic Landmark designation and waive all required zoning fees.
