ORDINANCE

APPROVING CONTRACTS WITH GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF SAN ANTONIO AND BURKETT ARBOR CARE, LLC TO PROVIDE TREE AND PALM MAINTENANCE AND REMOVAL SERVICES FOR VARIOUS CITY DEPARTMENTS, FUNDED THROUGH THE DEPARTMENTS' FY 2019 OPERATING BUDGETS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio issued a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposal (RFCSP) to provide various City Departments with tree and palm maintenance and removal services on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the RFCSP allowed for contract awards based upon three groupings of City departments, namely, the Building and Equipment Services Department, Aviation Department, and various other City Departments; and

WHEREAS, three proposals were received, deemed responsive and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends Goodwill Industries of San Antonio for award of contract for the Building and Equipment Services Department (Group 1) and various departments (Group 3); and

WHEREAS, staff recommends Burkett Arbor Care, LLC for award of contract for the Aviation Department (Group 2); **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposals submitted by Goodwill Industries of San Antonio (Groups 1 and 3) and Burkett Arbor Care, LLC (Group 2) to provide the City with tree and palm maintenance and removal services on an as needed basis for a total estimated cost of \$380,000.00 annually are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the score summaries and contracts are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 2. The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Goodwill Industries of San Antonio and Burkett Arbor Care, LLC. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2019 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term period of this contract approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
