

ORDINANCE

AMENDING CHAPTER 35, UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE, OF THE CITY CODE OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, BY AMENDING THE HABITAT COMPLIANCE FORM.

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WHEREAS, the Habitat Compliance Form was established by the City Council of San Antonio, Texas, on August 20, 2009, under Ordinance No. 2009-08-20-0652; and

WHEREAS, the Habitat Compliance Form is a tool to communicate development activity to the City of San Antonio's State and Federal partners; and

WHEREAS, the City Council Community Health and Equity Committee directed City Staff on August 7, 2018, to convene a task force to recommend changes to the Habitat Compliance Form to ensure that the form was clear and understandable; and

WHEREAS, the task force held committee meetings to develop a revised Habitat Compliance Form with input from a variety of interested members of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing, considered, and made a recommendation of approval of the revised Habitat Compliance Form on March 13, 2019; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 35 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, the Unified Development Code, is hereby amended by adding language that is underlined (added) and deleting the language that is stricken (~~deleted~~) to the existing text as set forth in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Chapter 35, Appendix B, Section 35-B133, of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 35-B133. - Habitat Compliance Form.

- (a) The owner of property subject to this chapter who submits an application to the City of San Antonio for development on/of a tract of land greater than two (2) acres in area shall submit a Habitat Compliance Form in accordance with the provisions of this section.
- (b) A property owner shall, through a signed and completed Habitat Compliance Form:
 - (1) Indicate obtainment of a section 10(a) permit, section 7 biological opinion, participation in a Regional Habitat Conservation Plan or submittal of an endangered species survey to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for properties located in Karst zones 1 or 2 as outlined in the 2008 Draft Recovery Plan for Bexar County Karst Invertebrates, available on U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's website; or for properties identified as potential Golden-Cheeked Warbler Habitat as outlined in Texas Parks and Wildlife Department Management Guidelines for the Golden-cheeked Warbler in Rural Landscapes, *available on their website*; or,

- (2) Complete a signed, sworn, and notarized affidavit indicating a biologist survey was either not completed, or not provided to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, that found that no species would be impacted by the activity subject to the application to the City of San Antonio.

The application to the City of San Antonio shall be deemed incomplete if the Habitat Compliance Form, and affidavit if applicable, is not completed and signed, and/or the information provided is deemed to be inaccurate.

SECTION 3. All other provisions of Chapter 35 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, shall remain in full force and effect including the penalties for violations as made and provided for in Section 35-491.

SECTION 4. Should any Article, Section, Part, Paragraph, Sentence, Phrase, Clause, or Word of this ordinance, for any reason be held illegal, inoperative, or invalid, or if any exception to or limitation upon any general provision herein contained be held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective, the remainder shall, nevertheless, stand effective and valid as if it had been enacted and ordained without the portion held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk is directed to publish notice of this ordinance amending City Code, Chapter 35, Unified Development Code. Publication shall be in a newspaper in the City in accordance with Section 17 of the City Charter.

SECTION 6. The publishers of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas are authorized to amend said Code to reflect the changes adopted herein and to correct typographical errors and to index, format and number paragraphs to conform to the existing code.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
